The Journal of Law and Public Policy is an open access journal with a double-blind peer review process that publishes original scholarship on the interface between law and public policy at the national, regional, and international levels. Contributions that examine the process of public interest decision making are especially welcomed. Articles must advance interdisciplinarity in the field of law and justice with a strong focus on socio-economic and political contexts. In addition to academic quality, the journal encourages writing that is accessible to a wide range of readers such as policymakers, researchers, faculty, and students of law and public policy across the world. We welcome empirical, historical, and comparative analyses that are grounded in theoretical debates.

Founded in 2014, the *Journal of Law and Public Policy* is published twice a year by the National Law School of India University, Bengaluru. This includes one general issue and one theme-based issue.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION

JLPP publishes two issues a year, one general issue and one special issue. For general

issues, papers can be submitted any time of the year. You will receive initial feedback

within a week of submission. For special issues, submission dates vary; please consult

the special issue call on the journal website for submission guidelines and timelines.

HOW TO SUBMIT

For research articles, authors are requested to submit their manuscript electronically to

the journal's online submission system. For Legislative Notes/Case Comments and

Book Reviews, please see the respective guidelines on the Submission Guidelines page

before proceeding. For all categories of articles, authors are also requested to go

through the General Submission Guidelines and the Style Guidelines before submitting.

JLPP follows the online-first publication model. This allows completed articles to be

published online prior to their inclusion in a final print and online journal issue. This

significantly reduces the lead time between submission and publication.
