NLSJ Book Reviews are meant to offer critical reflections on the latest academic publications across legal and allied interdisciplinary scholarship. They should offer critical reflections on the book, place it within existing scholarship on the subject/theme,

To contribute a Book Review

Book Reviews are generally solicited by the journal's Editorial Board. Interested authors are strongly encouraged to submit a short proposal (200-300 words) in advance at nlsj@nls.ac.in. This proposal should include:

- key book details (title, author, publisher, year, or a link to the publisher's book page),
- a note on what makes the work timely, compelling and relevant to readers of legal and allied interdisciplinary scholarship, and
- your engagement with, or expertise in, the subject area.

Length: 2,000 to 4,000 words
